MEMORANDUM ORDER

Pro se plaintiff Edosa Addley Festus Ogbemor (“Ogbemor”) filed the instant civil rights complaint on February 29, 2024. Doc. 1. On May 22, 2024, Judge Doughty, adopting the undersigned’s Report and Recommendation (doc. 2) dismissed the matter. Doc. 4. The Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals vacated the Court’s judgment and remanded the case for further proceedings on March 18, 2025. Doc. 6. Plaintiff filed an Amended Complaint on May 5, 2025. Doc. 11.

On May 27, 2025, and May 29, 2025, Plaintiff filed a Motion/Request for Entry of Default (doc. 13) and Motion for Default Judgment (doc. 14).

Plaintiff’s civil action remains on initial review pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§1915 and 1915(e)(2). As such, his motions are premature.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff’s Motion/Request for Entry of Default (doc. 13) and Motion for Default Judgment (doc. 14) are **DENIED**.
